## HISTORY, MARITIME ADVENTURE AND THE THRILL OF THE RACE!!

### Day One

Experience the excitement of the **Indian River Lifesaving Station Museum!** Learn about the heroic men that risked their lives to rescue those in peril and prevent shipwrecks along the Delaware's pristine coastline. Originally constructed in 1876 for use by the U.S. Lifesaving Service, the Station and Museum are situated on the Delaware Seashore State Park Beach and are listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Enjoy a nostalgic trip back in time as you tour the actual station where heroes prepared for duty!

Next, experience the Atlantic Ocean breezes as you stroll along the boardwalk at Rehoboth Beach. Indulge yourself at Rehoboth's fabulous boutique shops and vast array of eateries or just sit back, relax, and take in all of the wonderful sights and sounds Rehoboth Beach has to offer. Eat like a local and enjoy Delaware's legendary **Grotto Pizza** followed by homemade taffy and fudge from **Candy Kitchen**. Yum!

Ahoy matey! The next stop is a pirate adventure as you embark on our very own **Kalmar Nyckel**, the Tall Ship of Delaware. Join the captain and crew on a one-of-a-kind exploration of the Delaware Bay! The Kalmar Nyckel is Delaware's seagoing goodwill ambassador that serves as a sea and land-based learning and recreational vessel. All aboard!

Finally, conclude your day with a visit to **Woodburn**, the home of Delaware's group-tour friendly Governor, Jack Markell. Woodburn has served as the official residence of the Governor of Delaware since it was purchased by the State in 1965. This Middle Period Georgian mansion was built in 1798 by Charles Hillyard, III, and is a must-see attraction for the Delaware traveler!

### Day Two

Are you ready for a top-speed adventure? Experience a personalized tour of the fastest racetrack in Delaware! Best known as the "**Monster Mile**," **Dover International Speedway** is a one-mile, high-banked oval in Dover, Delaware. The formidable track has been a fixture on the NASCAR Sprint Cup Series schedule since its inception in 1969 and continues to host NASCAR's national touring series. Gain a new perspective of NASCAR and get behind the scenes at the Speedway with a guided track tour of the Monster Mile!

Experience the beauty of the arts at one of Delaware's finest galleries. The **Delaware Art Museum** is best known for its collection of British Pre-Raphaelite artworks by Wilmington native Howard Pyle and fellow American illustrators, and urban landscapes by John Sloan. The Museum connects people to art, offering an inclusive and essential community resource. Through its collections, exhibitions, and programs, the Museum generates creative energy that sustains, enriches, empowers, and inspires!

Top off your day with a visit to **Mount Cuba Center**, a lovely 630-acre DuPont country estate. Mt. Cuba is committed to the study, conservation, and appreciation of plants native to the Appalachian Piedmont Region through garden presentation, instruction, and research. Gain knowledge about the history, design, and plant diversity that make the Mt. Cuba Center a unique regional treasure. As you tour the Georgian treasure, gaze down for a panoramic view of the scenic Brandywine Valley.
