Hops, Grapes and History – Kent County

Fordham and **Old Dominion** beers and ales, though distinctively different in taste, are both brewed at the same facility in Dover, less than 10 minutes from the historic **John Dickinson Plantation**. So be sure to set aside time for a taste of Delaware colonial history when you plan your ale tasting in Dover.

Wine is one of the “holiest” of spirits, so you'll definitely want to make the ten minute hop over to **Barratt’s Chapel** when you visit **Pizzadili Winery** in Felton. Known as the “Cradle of Methodism,” the Chapel is the oldest surviving church building in the United States built by and for Methodists. Pizzadili Winery grows their own grapes and makes all of their own wines on the premises. You will find more than one that you will enjoy!
