The Makings of American History, Handcrafted Brews and Award-winning Wines

Day One

Experience a soul-quenching adventure in the First State as you embark on an exploration of the **Delaware Wine and Ale Trail!** The Trail features thirteen unique wineries and breweries spread throughout the state that are ready to serve up a tasting, tour, and a treasured experience!

Work up a thirst as you enjoy a Paddles and Pints kayak ride along the beautiful **Broadkill River** that flows through Milton. This scenic wildlife sanctuary is home to heron, turtles, eagles, and more! After a trek along the River, towel off and head directly to the famous **Dogfish Head Craft Brewery** also tucked away in Milton. Take a tour of the facility and sample a pint (or two) of a savory 'off-centered' Dogfish Ale. Yum!

Next, venture to **Historic Lewes** to encounter **Fort Miles** in **Cape Henlopen State Park**. During WWII, Fort Miles provided protection for the Delaware River which was a critical coastal trading route for Wilmington, Delaware, and surrounding areas. Now, a part of the National Register of Historic Places, the Fort is popular with history buffs, veterans, and families. Now that you are feeling fine, head to **Nassau Valley Vineyards** for some award-winning wine! Visit Delaware's first farm winery which produces and develops a wide variety of delicious wines from sweet to dry and white to red.

Day Two

Awaken your visual senses at the **Biggs Museum of American Art** in Dover! The Biggs Museum features a vast display of American Art including sculptures, paintings, furniture, and collections. After you have nourished your creative side, travel to the lush vineyards of Pizzadili Winery in Felton. Family-owned **Pizzadili Vineyard and Winery** creates and crafts all of their wines on the estate. Enjoy the delectable wines, acres of grape vines, fruit trees, and flourishing farmland!

Take a journey back in time and discover the **Air Mobility Command Museum** located at the Dover Air Force Base. This expansive facility offers the chance to climb inside a C-133 airplane, experience the excitement of a flight simulator, and witness a WWII bomber complete with nose art and more! Old-time music streams through the speakers as you take in the sights of vintage aircraft and historical exhibits. After your tour, 'hop' over to **Fordham and Old Dominion Brewery Company** in Dover. Take a brewery tour and sample ales and lagers that are locally hand-crafted for your tasting pleasure!

Day Three

Visit the **Historic Houses of Odessa!** This remarkable town played an essential role in commercial life along the Delaware River as a grain shipping harbor. Take a leisurely stroll along the cobblestone streets and admire the beautiful homes and gardens. Don't miss the open hearth cooking demonstration featuring scrumptious homemade desserts. Yummy! Next, travel to **Stewart's Brewing Company** in Bear. Established in 1995, Stewart's is New Castle County's first brewpub featuring handcrafted beer that encompasses all styles. Beers are inspired by English, German, French, and Belgium styles with a unique American twist!

Be sure to stop at Nemours and bask in the historical splendor of the **Nemours Mansion and Gardens!** A dazzling 300-acre, 47,000 square foot French chateau and country estate in the style of Louis XVI, Nemours was the estate of the late Alfred I du Pont and is located on the grounds of the leading children's hospital that also bears his name. The house is decorated with rare rugs, antique tapestries, oil paintings, and decorative arts. Enjoy a walk around the sculpture-filled, formal French gardens and a visit to the chauffeur's garage, where immaculate antique cars are on display. Conclude your journey with a memorable visit to **Twin Lakes Brewing Company** in Greenville. Knowledgeable tour guides will take you on a journey of their distinctive brewing process, explain traditions of the Brandywine Valley legacy, and share the moments in American history that took place on their brewery site.
