Wednesday

First State Heritage Park Visitor Center

Here a costumed guide can walk you to The Green, Dover's nationally recognized historic spot, and weave tales of patriots, poisonings and suffragettes.

Biggs Museum of American Art offers 14 galleries of silver, furniture, painting and decorative arts from Delaware Valley artisans.

Johnson Victrola Museum holds one of the most complete collections of Victrolas. The history of recorded sound is one of innovation, chance and timing.

Air Mobility Command Museum at Dover Air Force Base. C5s regularly fly overhead and airlift history is depicted with 24 restored aircraft and displays inside and out.

Thursday

Bombay Hook National Wildlife Refuge, a 15,000 acre delight of waterfowl and shorebirds off the Rt. 9 Scenic Byway. Follow the auto tour and stop at various lookouts along the way for pictures or hiking. For lunch today, pick a local seafood restaurant in the tiny fishing village of Leipsic.



Delaware State Police Museum. Antique patrol vehicles are on display and a crime scene with clues waits for your solution! The advances in crime solving technology are amazing.
